First and Second, Third and Fourth Couples, Right and Left, Turn partners, forming in two lines facing, Vis a Vis, Four Ladies right hands across, and back, forming the Grand Cross, Ballance and form two lines facing, Vis a Vis, Swing opposite Madies, with right hand and then with the left, finishing in a Circle. Grand Round and all Gallop to places
