




pij.

Esempi sono questi, che non solo han suscitato nel petto d'ogn'uno la meraviglia, ma di più han somministrato à me motiuo bastante à farmi essercitar l'ingegno, con la carica, che tengo di Maestro di Cappella in questa sua Catedrale, nella compositione de presenti Mottetti, e di publicarli anche sotto la protectione del suo chiarissimo Nome, confidato in ciò da quella benignità, con cui ordinariamente si è degnata porger cortese orecchio alle mie fatiche Musicali. Le quali ancorche per se stesse si conoscano priue delle vaghezze dell'arte, e scarse delle bellezze del sapere: tutta volta arricchite co'l valore del suo Patrocinio, e patrocinate con l'autorità del suo valore confidano di comparire più che gloriose nel Teatro del Mondo.
